#### **INSIDE DLSZ Campus**

- Quick unloading/loading ONLY at the designated areas inside and outside the campus.
- Arrive for pick-up five minutes after dismissal.
- Take another round if there are no parking spaces available inside the campus.

- \* ACTUAL OPENING OF GATES VARIES DEPENDING ON DISMISSAL. PLEASE, SEE STUDENTS' SCHEDULE
- Motorists should observe the speed limit of 5 KPH inside the campus.
- STRICTLY NO PARKING after drop-off period at Gate 2, St. Joseph, AAVA Parking areas and along the perimeter areas of the school during class hours.
- Portions of St. Joseph, AAVA (across Gate 5) and Gate 2
  parking areas are reserved for recognized legal school
  transport providers subject to compliance of terms and
  conditions by the school. Private vehicles may use the area
  for quick loading/unloading only.
- 6. Visitors are highly encouraged to transact official business with the school during class hours to avoid traffic congestion during dismissal time. Visitors must present proper identification at Gate 2, Gate 6 or Gate 7 Information Counter. They will be issued Car Pass, Visitor's ID and monitoring slip to be returned after their transaction.
- 7. Engines are to be switched-off while parked/waiting.
- 8. Refrain from using mobile phones while driving.
- Visitors riding motorcycles must enter Gate 2 and park their vehicle at the designated area adjacent to the Security office.
- No School Sticker-No Entry Policy is strictly implemented in DLSZ. School stickers are available at the Campus Services Office of DLSZ. All school-bound vehicles are required to secure village stickers.
- 11. Please observe courtesy to other vehicles.
- 12. All motorists violating traffic rules inside the campus will be given the following sanctions:

### **OUTSIDE DLSZ Campus**

# ACACIA GATE

 The Acacia Gate will be generally open to DLSZ-bound vehicles from 6:00am to 6:00pm. However, all DLSZ-bound vehicles entering the village from 7:00am - 8:00am and 3:30pm - 4:30pm should use the Madrigal Gate.

### MOTORIST ALONG UNIVERSITY AVENUE

- University Avenue is three-lane traffic from Caliraya St. to Acacia St. from 6:30 – 8:00am and 2:00 – 5:00pm. Residentside is two-way traffic for residents from Acacia St. to Caliraya St.
- University Ave. will be designated loading/unloading street for students.
- Parallel parking along the perimeter of the school for quick loading/ unloading (maximum 15 minutes) is allowed between Gates 2 and 5 provided hazard lights are switched on and drivers are inside the vehicles while waiting.
- 4. Stopping is allowed in mid-lane to unload or load students.
- 5. No parking, waiting, loading and unloading at residential side. **MOTORIST ALONG MOLAVE ST.**
- Molave St. is one-way from University Avenue going to north. Two-way traffic from 6:30am – 8:00am, 10:00am – 12:00nn and 2:00pm – 5:00pm.
- 2. Vehicles entering Molave St. must only come from University Ave. Molave St. has three (3) lanes:
  - Inner right lane is for private vehicles entering Gate 7 to drop-off students in front of the Lower Grades building lobby.
  - Middle lane is designated for private vehicles and school buses entering Gate 7 going to the St. Joseph Building (Gr. 5 area) to drop three or more passengers.
  - Outer left lane is a pass thru lane going to Ma. Cristina St
  - No drop-off/pick-up along Molave St. except after Gate 7 or Kinder Gate

### MOTORIST ALONG MA. CRISTINA AND CALIRAYA ST.

- Ma. Cristina St. from Angat St. to Caliraya St. and Caliraya Street from Ma.Cristina St. to University Ave. shall be one way from 7:00 – 8:00am and 2:30 – 5:00pm. Two-way is allowed after the said periods.
- Strictly no loading and pedestrian exit at Gate 3 between 3:30

   5:00 pm along Ma. Cristina St. Vehicles must enter Gate 1 to fetch. No parking is allowed on either side (residential and school side).
- 3. Loading/unloading is only allowed on the campus side of the street in the MORNING before Gate 3.
- 4. Loading/unloading in the afternoon is allowed after 5:00 p.m. **OTHER REMINDERS:**
- Only cars on official business with AAVA and DLSZ stickers shall be allowed to park in the AAVA parking across Gate 5. No prolonged parking of any vehicle shall be allowed.
- All school-bound vehicles must secure AAVA stickers to enter and exit gates without depositing their driver's license.
- Non-resident fetchers are allowed to enter the village 15-minutes before the dismissal period.
- DLSZ may endorse applications for AAVA stickers. The terms, conditions and cost of the sticker are indicated on the AAVA sticker application form.
- 5. The above scheme and rules will be jointly implemented by Barangay Ayala-Alabang pursuant to Barangay Ordinance 93-01 and DLSZ Security. AAVA Security or deputized personnel shall issue citation tickets for non-compliance to any of the above mentioned rules and regulations.
- Village roads are the jurisdiction of the AAVA security. DLSZ security is to maintain traffic and pedestrian discipline at the gates and inside the campus.
- This is a general traffic scheme. AAV and DLSZ reserve the right to change the traffic scheme without prior notice.
- 8. The speed limit is 40 kph for secondary roads, 20 kph for school zones and 60kph for the main road.
- 9. PARKING OR WAITING OF ILLEGAL SCHOOL TRANSPORT SERVICE IS PROHIBITED IN ANY AREA AROUND THE SCHOOL OR INSIDE THE VILLAGE.




