Dearest **Lasallian Students and Parents,**

Greetings of Peace from the DLSZ - High School Student Representative Coordinating Council (HS-SRCC)!

According to an article of the Philippine Inquirer last March 2, 2017, *“Majority leader Rodolfo Fariñas said the Committee on Rules which he chairs will field House Bill 4727 to the plenary for third and final reading approval on Tuesday, March 7”* (Cayabyab, 2017). This refers to the bill reimposing the death penalty.

In this light, the HS-SRCC, together with the rest of the Lasallian community, is planning to take a stand against the reimposition of capital punishment for the reason that it is anti-poor and it fosters a fear-driven society. It also violates several human rights and provides opportunities for abuse and exploitation.

Contrary to the government’s present stance, the Lasallian community strongly advocates for rehabilitative measures and the proper education in order to reintegrate criminal offenders into society. This is what we view as a more sustainable and humane solution to the problems of our nation.

We have decided to put our stand into action through a Noise for Life and Prayer Walk activity on Wednesday, March 8, 2017. Different organizations, including the DLSZ Animo Squad, CMO Affiliate Organizations, and student bands, will participate in this worthwhile event. The scheduled noise barrage will be happening simultaneously across the country.

In the Prayer Walk, students will pray the rosary together while walking along the campus, University Avenue and Maria Cristina Street.

These events will be given coverage and posted live on Facebook.


