



MLD Use for Grade 3 to 6 Students for AY 2022-2023

Students from Grade 3 up to Grade 6 will need to bring their mobile learning devices (MLD) to school when attending on-campus classes. Please see the recommended specs below:

To ensure the success of Hybrid/Online Learning among DLSZ Students, they must have the means of access to and ways of learning in flexible online and offline learning modalities using a suitable learning device.

For this purposes, we recommend any available learning device (branded or clone) that has equivalent specifications to any of the following:

- Android Tablet/Smartphone with Android OS version 8 or higher
- Windows Laptop/desktop with Windows 8.1 or higher; Browsers: Chrome v.68 or higher, Edge (Chromium-based) v.80 or higher, Firefox v.66 or higher; the device should be able to run a fully updated modern browser (Edge, Firefox, Chrome, Safari); generally, one with 8GB RAM and a fairly recent processor (2 or 3 years old) is recommended, but some have been able to manage well with older devices with 4GB RAM.
- Chromebook with ChromeOS v.68 or higher
- iPad with at least 32GB and can run iOS 13 and up
- iMac/MacBook with MacOS 10.11 (El Capitan) or higher with MacOS 10.11 (El Capitan) or higher; Browsers: Chrome v.68 or higher, Edge (Chromium-based) v.80 or higher, Firefox v.66 or higher

Please provide inexpensive wired earphones.

A tablet, preferably an iPad, is highly recommended for ease of use and compatibility with the teachers' apps for active and collaborative learning in the classroom, particularly for Grade 3 and 4 students. These devices are also more portable and manageable for young learners compared with laptops. However, for Grade 5 or 6, you may consider providing a laptop since they can still use it in Junior High School.

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
