Asynchronous learning is a type of remote learning where students are provided with content and tasks that they need to accomplish within a time frame using an online platform such as a learning management system (LMS). Interaction between the teacher and students (and among students) does not take place in real time. No face-to-face class meeting happens, even online. Students engage in class materials and complete work at their own pace, typically within a given time frame, often using discussion boards to drive peer-to-peer engagement.
