Smell Along the Creek Beside DLSZ

As part of our continued safety response to the strong fuel smell detected along the creek beside DLSZ, we are implementing an early dismissal for Grades 5–10 students in Alabang Campus and suspending onsite classes for the Br. Rafael Donato FSC Night High School (BRafeNHS) today, August 5, 2025.

Please be advised of the following dismissal time:

Grades 5 and 6: Dismissal at 12:00 PM

Grades 7 to 10: Dismissal at 12:30 PM

These grade levels will shift to structured asynchronous learning for any remaining scheduled subjects. Please note that all after-school activities and trainings will be **postponed**.

Dismissal Reminders:

Students will be released through their usual dismissal gates and protocols. Departure
Permits will no longer be issued. Parents do not need to fetch their children from the
classrooms.

- Face masks are strongly recommended for all fetchers and students.
- RTSP vans will be allowed to pick up students at Caliraya Parking and in front of St. La Salle Building, with guidance from the Security Team

Health and Safety Advisory:

- Difficulty breathing
- Asthma or allergic rhinitis flare-ups
- Other respiratory concerns
